Provision of a Non-NHS Occupational Hepatitis B Vaccination

If necessary, we are happy to discuss with you the provision of a non-NHS vaccination service for your employee, however, you must first have carried out the appropriate risk assessment. We will also require your employee's written consent.

An estimate of the cost of providing the non-NHS service is detailed below

Consultations	£50.00 (based on 20 minutes)
Private Prescription charge for any vaccinations	£13.00 per item There will also be a fee payable to the Pharmacy
Blood test for laboratory analysis	£45 per sample (there may be multiple samples) + £10 handling fee
Certificate	£25 - we will only issue and charge for a certificate if you have implicitly requested that it be produced

Fees are correct at the time of print (March 2022) and may be subject to increase.

Please note that there may be a wait for an appointment, as General Medical Services work receives priority.

If you wish us to provide this service we will require 1) copy of Risk Assessment, 2) Employee's signed consent, 3) Employees Hepatitis B vaccination history, and 4) written confirmation that you wish to proceed and are happy to cover the costs. On receipt of these 4 items, an invoice can be generated and appointment can be arranged for your Employee.
